Although various legal rights have been formulated and implemented by the government to preserve and protect the inherent rights of every woman, lack of proper knowledge and information on the same have hindered the due diligence of women legal rights and justice.

Prof Ratna Dutta in her address stated that women cells in the colleges help in resolving the problems of the students, thereby helping to make them aware of their rights.

The workshop was attended by more than 150 students of MDKG College, who later on interacted with the resource person on topics related to women rights.
